

Driving Instructions: Upington to Sandfontein (approx. 4.5 hours' drive)

- 1. There are signs in Upington that show the way to the Namibian border on route 10.
- 2. The border is crossed at Ariamsvlei.
- 3. Once in Namibia, drive to Karasburg (which is the first town you will reach after the border, and is about 110km away).
- 4. Refuel in Karasburg.
- 5. When leaving Karasburg, take the Warmbad road (but note you are not going all the way to Warmbad).
- 6. The Warmbad road is a gravel road. Look out for the D208 which will be at a right turn about 10km from Karasburg.
- 7. Take the D208 for about 70km. You will see Sandfontein's entrance / sign on the left hand side of the road.
- 8. Follow signs to the lodge (about 19km).
- 9. The GPS co-ordinates for the airstrip are SE28-43-11 E18-30-38 (the airstrip is about 5km west of the lodge).
- 10. The GPS co-ordinates for the lodge are S28-42-24 E18-33-16.



<u>Tips</u>

- A) NOTE: Once you're about an hour from Sandfontein, there is no further cell/mobile phone reception.
- B) While a 4x4 is recommended to get to Sandfontein, many guests have come to Sandfontein in 2-wheel drive vehicles. Driving slowly and consistently is recommended.
- C) Namibia generally has very good, wide and well-graded dirt roads. Many drivers end up driving too fast on these roads, especially when they see others doing it. Accidents do occur as a result. Please drive slowly (max 80km/h on the best dirt roads) and carefully. ALWAYS wear seat belts.


